Paul Fox is an accomplished film and television director with an impressive array of award winning feature films, music videos, short films, and television productions to his credit. Upon graduating from New York's School of Visual Arts, Paul's thesis film, *Last Round Up*, won Paul awards for Best Film, Best Director, and Best Editor. The film went on to win Best Fiction Film at the Mexico City Film Festival, and was invited to the Sundance Film Festival. Paul then participated in the Director's Lab program at Norman Jewison's prestigious Canadian Film Centre.

Paul's first feature film, *The Dark Hours*, is a taut psychological thriller that was released through Capri Releasing in Fall 2005. The film received international acclaim and won numerous awards including Best Film at the Austin Fantastic Film Festival, Best Feature at the Dead by Dawn festival in Edinburgh Scotland, Best Horror Feature and Best Director at the Phoenix International Horror & Sci-Fi Film Festival, the 'Best of Puchon' award at the PiFan International Fantastic Film Festival in Korea, the 'Midnight X-Treme' award at the Sitges Fantastic Film Festival in Spain, and the Best Film Award at the New York City Horror Film Festival.

Paul's second feature, *Everything's Gone Green*, is a wry coming-of-age comedy with a satiric bite written by acclaimed author Douglas Coupland ('Generation X') and starring Paulo Costanzo ('Joey,' 'Road Trip,') that premiered at the 2006 Toronto International Film Festival. 'Green' has gone on to win awards at the Vancouver and Edmonton Film Festivals and has been invited to several international fests including the Pusan International in South Korea and the Glasgow Film Festival in Scotland. 'Green' also won Best Screenwriting and Best Feature Length Drama at the 2007 Leo Awards. The film had its US launch at the SXSW Film Festival in Austin Texas and was released theatrically in the US and Canada in April 2007.

Paul is one of two directors helming **Schitt's Creek**, a comedy series for CBC and POP starring Eugene Levy, Catherine O'Hara and Chris Elliott, which recently completed filming its second season. He also directed the pilot for **The Pinkertons**, a series set in 1860s Missouri starring Angus Macfadyen (*Braveheart*, *Turned*). Other TV includes **Rookie Blue** for ABC/Global, **Beauty and the Beast** for The CW, **Being Erica** and **The Republic of Doyle** for CBC, **Bitten** for SPACE/eOne, **Lost Girl** and **Haven** for Showcase/SyFy, **Played** and **The Listener** for CTV, **Living In Your Car** for HBOCanada, **The Murdoch Mysteries** for Citytv/Alibi(UK), and MOWs **Making Mister Right** and **Before You Say 'I Do'**. Paul is currently directing multiple episodes of the new CBC dramatic series, **This Life**.

Paul is in development on several feature projects, including dark comedy **The Great Perhaps**, suspense thriller **The Mysteries of Ice Fishing**, action dramas **The Valiant** and **The Last Outlaw**, an adaptation of the award-winning play **East of Berlin**, and **Red Dog**, a western.
