

# PAUL FOX

## DIRECTOR BIOGRAPHY

Paul Fox is an accomplished filmmaker with an impressive array of award-winning feature films, episodic television, music videos and short films to his credit. A graduate of New York's School of Visual Arts, Paul's thesis film, ***Last Round Up***, won numerous awards and was invited to the Sundance Film Festival. Paul's first feature, ***The Dark Hours*** (2005), is a taut psychological thriller that received much acclaim and numerous awards at festivals around the world. His second film, ***Everything's Gone Green***, is a wry coming-of-age comedy written by acclaimed author Douglas Coupland (*Generation X*) and starring Paulo Costanzo (*Designated Survivor, Royal Pains*), which premiered at the 2006 Toronto International Film Festival and was released in 2007 to excellent notices in Canada and the U.S.

For television, Paul has directed 18 episodes of ***Schitt's Creek***, the acclaimed CBC/POP/Netflix comedy series starring Eugene Levy, Catherine O'Hara and Chris Elliott. In 2016, Paul won a Canadian Screen Award for Best Direction in a Comedy Program for his *Schitt's Creek* Season One episode, "The Cabin", and also received Directors Guild of Canada nominations for his direction in both Season One and Season Two. He also directed the pilot for ***The Pinkertons***, a western series set in 1860s Missouri starring Angus Macfadyen (*Braveheart, Turned*).

Most recently, Paul directed episodes of the acclaimed CBC/Netflix drama ***Anne with an E***, the Netflix/Discovery period action series ***Frontier*** starring Jason Momoa, and multiple episodes of the new CBC comedy series ***Workin' Moms***, created by Catherine Reitman.

Other television credits include ***Rookie Blue*** for ABC/Global, ***Beauty and the Beast*** for The CW, ***Being Erica***, ***The Republic of Doyle*** and ***This Life*** for CBC, ***Bitten*** for SyFy/SPACE, ***Lost Girl*** and ***Haven*** for SyFy/Showcase, ***Played*** and ***The Listener*** for CTV, ***Living In Your Car*** for HBO Canada, ***The Murdoch Mysteries*** for CityTV/Alibi(UK), and the MOWs ***Making Mister Right*** and ***Before You Say 'I Do'***.

Paul is in development on several television and feature projects, including crime series ***Le Bronx***, dark comedy ***The Great Perhaps***, suspense thriller ***The Mysteries of Ice Fishing***, action dramas ***The Valiant*** and ***The Last Outlaw***, an adaptation of the award-winning play ***East of Berlin***, and ***Red Dog***, a Western.
